
About Procirca

The Procirca Simulation Center has modern cardiopulmonary bypass (CPB), extra-corporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO) and ventricular assist devices (VAD) equioment available for use by individuals or teams. Perfusionists, physicians, health care providers and industry professionals can gain a more complete understanding of CPB, ECMO & VAD through demonstrations, hands-on learning exercises and high fidelity simulation supported by didactic training.
